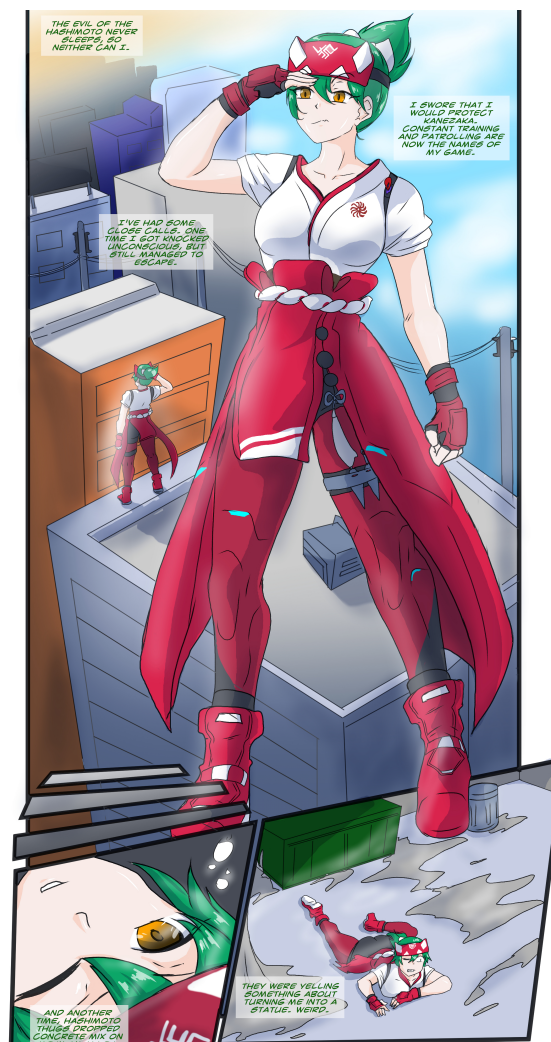


Guardian's Fall

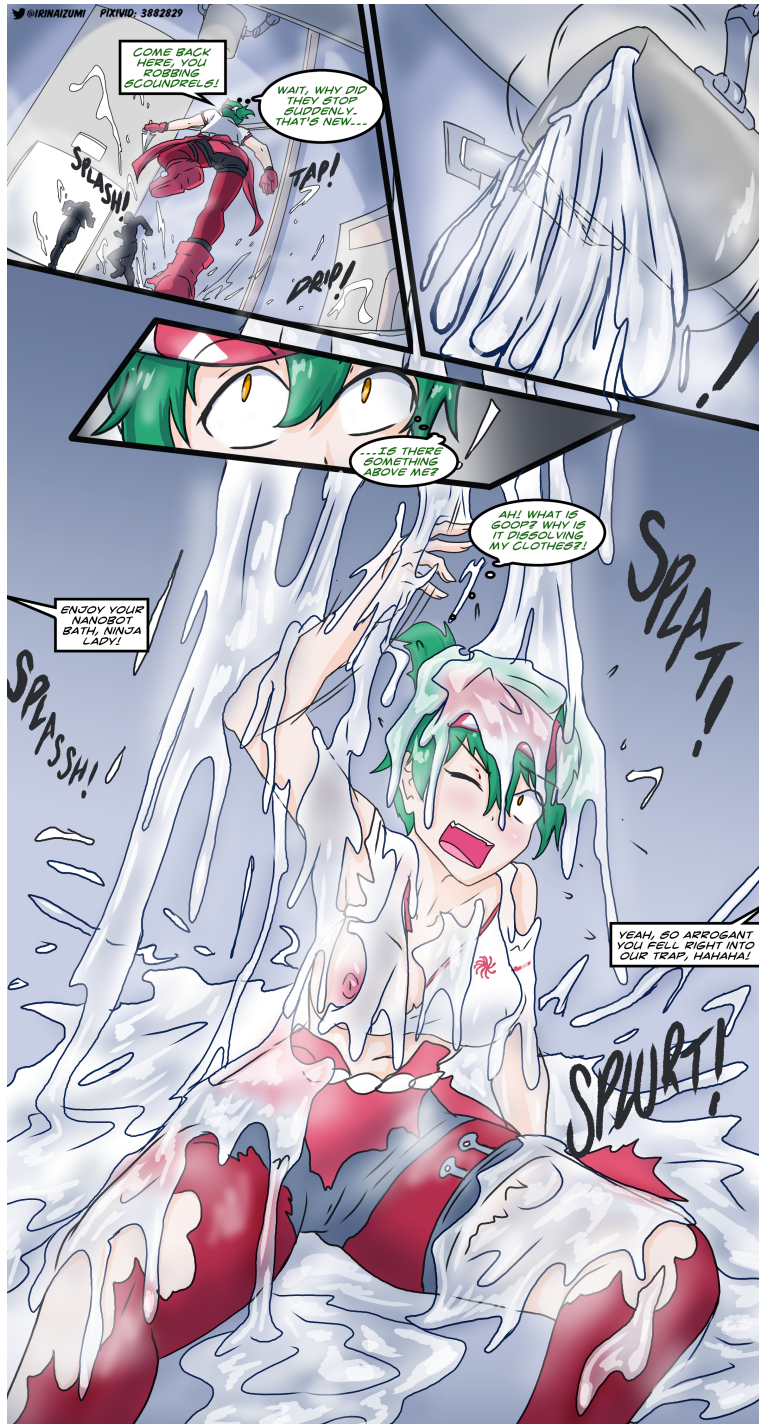

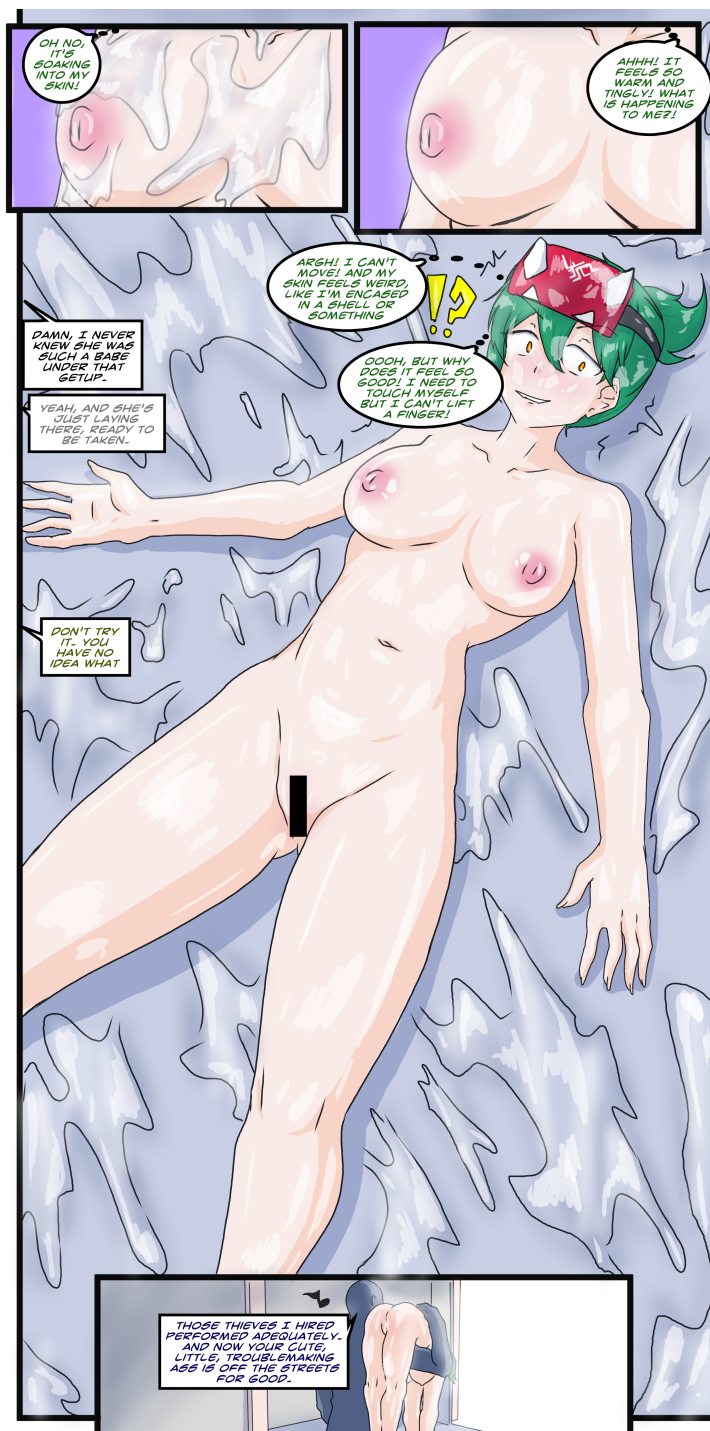
