

Kruleboy leather cloth Step-by-step

Paints required: Krule boy leather cloth

- Agrax Earthshade (GW Wash)
- Abaddon black
- Dark sand (Vallejo mc)
- Leather brown (Vallejo mc)
- Nuln oil (GW wash)





Before we start painting the miniature, we locate the light reflections on the leather cloth by taking a picture of it under our desklamp. I primed it in Chaos Black as it has a great shine to it. I have added a guide for how to locate light reflections in the post description.



We start by basecoating the leather with a 3:1 mix of leather brown & abaddon black.



We now glaze the frame of the light reflections roughly by adding 1 part of dark sand to the basecoat mix – we furthermore add scratches all around the leather by painting thin lines & dots – add 2-3 parts of water.

We now add a 1/2 part more of dark sand to the previous mix & glaze the middle of the light reflections on the leather – we furthermore add some scratches again here and there with the same mix. Finally we add some scratches in the very center of the light reflections & all sharpest edges, with pure dark sand.



We now wash the whole leather with agrax earthshade.



We now repeat the third & fourth step once again.



We now wash the deepest recesses & darkest areas (see reference photo of light reflections) with a 1:1 mix of agrax earthshade & nuln oil. Done © !
