Additional chords needed for intermediate bridge: F, C#m and Bm

Strum Pattern

1 & 2 & 3 & 4 &
D D U U D U

Strum Pattern - optional mutes on the 2nd and 4th beats.

1 & 2 & 3 & 4 &
D X U U X U

Strum Pattern - turn around, sometimes I use this one if the strum pattern happens two times on the same chord, the extra up makes the progression turn over.

1 & 2 & 3 & 4 &
D U D U U D U

In the bridge the strum patterns happens two times over the F and A chords.
