

WHY THIS MODEL?


I chose Gotrek cause I felt like painting a cute dwarf and who better than him?.


This model is part of my Twitch Monthly Giveaway plan, in which I paint and giveaway a model to one lucky subscriber of my Twitch Channel.

PAINTS USED IN THIS GUIDE


Vallejo MC: Black, Sunny Skintone, English Uniform, Yellow Ochre, Ivory Kimera Kolors: Orange






BASECOAT

The basecoat for this NMM Gold was a mix of VMC English Uniform, Kimera Orange and VMC Black roughly in a 70:20:10 mix ratio.



FIRST HIGHLIGHT

I added a touch of VMC Sunny Skintone and proceeded to highlight. When dealing with difficult to understand areas such as the heads on the belt, I tend to work with the bigger volumes and then focus on the details to make it easier for myself.



SECOND HIGHLIGHT

I made a mix 60:40 of VMC Yellow Ochre and Ivory and used it to place an highlight inside the previous layer to push the contrast.

With an even brighter color (more ivory) you can increase the highlights even further or do the edge highlights.



SHADING

I wanted to push the depth in the shadows and added a touch of black to the basecoat mix and used it to glaze in the recesses of all the NMM, to have a bit of a darker color in the shadows.



Complicated and small areas such as the heads on the belt are tough to paint, but with a bit of work and a more general approach at first followed by the detailing at a later time will make it easier to paint.
