



Stormcast female face & hair
Step-by-step

◆ Paints required:

Face & hair

- Cadian fleshtone
- Kislev flesh
- Leather brown (Vallejo mc)
- Screamer pink
- Rhinox hide
- Corvus black
- Skrag brown
- Dark sand (vallejo mc)
- Basic skin tone (Vallejo mc)





Before we start painting the miniature, we locate the light reflections on the face, by taking a picture of it under our desk lamp. I primed it in Chaos Black as it has a great shine to it. I have added a guide for how to locate light reflections in the post description.



We start by basecoating the skin with a 2:1 mix of cadian fleshtone & leather brown. We furthermore shade the eye sockets with corvus black & paint the eyes (Basic skin tone layer, black dot in the center & a white dot)

We now glaze in the frame of the light reflections on the skin, by adding $\frac{1}{2}$ part of kislef flesh to the basecoat mix – add 2-3 parts of water.



We now add $\frac{1}{2}$ part of screamer pink to the basecoat mix & shade underneath the cheek bones, forehead, chin, ears etc. We also shade all the deepest recesses in general, but here we add 1 full part of screamer pink to the basecoat mix. We furthermore add $\frac{1}{2}$ part more of kislev flesh to the previous mix & glaze towards the center of the light reflections.



We now add a $\frac{1}{2}$ part of basic skin tone to the previous mix & glaze the center of the light reflections on the skin.



We now add a ½ part of leather brown to the previous mix used for shading the skin & this time we shade the most shaded areas, like under the cheek bones, chin, ears & deepest recesses. Add 2-3 parts of water. We furthermore start working on the hair – we basecoat it with rhinox hide.

We now make a 2:1 mix of leather brown & rhinox hide & layer all the hair strains.



We now add a $\frac{1}{2}$ part of skrag brown & dark sand to the previous mix & layer towards the center of the light reflections on the hair – add 1-2 parts of water.

We now add 1 part of dark sand to the previous mix & glayer the center of the light reflections on the hair. Done 😊 !
