

CARNIVOROUS SHROOM

These carnivorous creatures resemble mushrooms – their looks during the day are calm and not suspicious at all. Only their size can let you distinguish them from regular fungi – they are enormous, often size of a tree.

BEHAVIOUR

Shrooms are nocturnal beasts, but they can be woken up during the daytime – therefore it is best to have caution, while approaching or passing them, unless you want to engage in a battle. Not just any battle, as they could be considered pack creatures, your endeavour can cost you a battle not just with one representative of their species, but a whole hoard. While sleeping they do not move, their horrid expressions disappear for their rest as they blend into surroundings.

The Observers mention in their scripts, that Shrooms can develop complex social relationships, especially when taking care of the offspring (who are not to be taken lightly as well). It is best not to underestimate young ones – they are as deadly as adults, can be incredibly fast and more eager to bounce around during encounter.

APPEARANCES

Their oldest representatives are said to reach even 120 ft, but it is very uncommon to meet – usually they are half of that size.

Shrooms' pattern resembles that of the Amanitas fungi, but it is said they can camouflage even further, by having brown or white colour scheme – especially when the colours are dominating in the surroundings.

When they wake up, their faces stretch out from stipe – it is worth mentioning that their stem, even as it may resemble regular fungi stem, is made of rather sticky and stretching substance. It is essential to remember during the encounter with Shrooms.

ORIGIN

It is not known where the Carnivorous Shrooms come from.

They are uncommon species and appear in packs, but no one has observed how they settle.

It was concluded, that they show increased activity during mid-autumn.

It is not uncommon for them to unhabituate area just before first frost - but no one has yet discovered where they are heading to.
