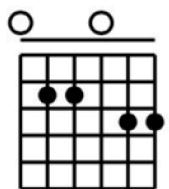

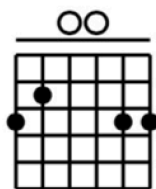
Chords Needed:

Note: These are examples of "busker's chords," which are simple shapes that allow you to keep one or more fingers in a fixed position as you transition from chord to chord. Notice that throughout the song, your ring and pinky fingers stay put on the third fret of the B and high E strings.

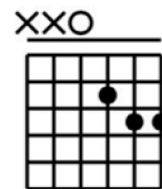

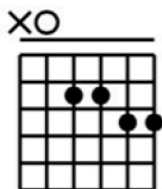

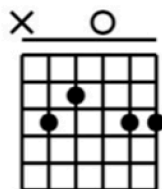
