

Throgg - Teeth
Step-by-step


Paints required:

⊗Teeth

- Mournfang brown
- Abaddon black
- Ushabti bone
- Screaming skull

Before we start painting the miniature, we locate the light reflections on the teeth, by taking a picture of it under our desklamp. I primed it in Chaos Black as it has a great shine to it. I have added a guide for how to locate light reflections in the post description.





We start by basecoating the teeth with a 1:2:1/3 part of ushabti bone, mournfang brown & abaddon black.

We now shade all the naturally shaded areas (see reference photo) with mournfang brown – add 2 parts of water.



We now add 1 part more of ushabti bone to the basecoat mix & glaze the frame of the light reflections on the teeth. Add 2-3 parts of water.

We now add 1 part of screaming skull & glaze the center of the light reflections & highlight the edges.





We now highlight the edges with pure screaming skull – add 1 part of water. We furthermore shade the deepest recesess with thinned down abaddon black - add 1-2 parts of water. Done ©!
