


How to Solo Without Scales - Simple Arpeggio Lead Guitar Hack






Section #1 - Chords in the Key of D


Each note in the major scale can be harmonized to form a complete chord. In this section, let's learn how to play each chord in the key of D major ascending up the neck. From there, we can learn to arpeggiate these chords to form the basis of a guitar solo.





Section #2 - Arpeggiating Chords in Dmaj
