Associating different bimbo archetypes to classic fairytale princesses was tons of fun. I hope you enjoy this as much as I enjoyed making it.



I had this image in my reference folder and knew I wanted to use it.

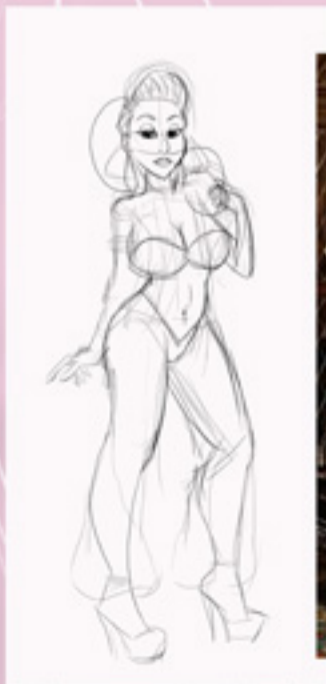

I attempted a Jersey Shore style. You be the judge of how much I succeeded...


