



**Terminator face skin
PDF tutorial**

Paints used :

- Succubus skin (Vallejo game color)
- Anthea skin (Vallejo game color)
- White
- Nocturnal red (Vallejo game color)





Before we start painting the miniature, we locate the light reflections on the skin, by taking a picture of it under our desk lamp. I primed it in Chaos black as it has a great shine to it. I have added a guide for how to locate light reflections in the patreon post.



We start by basecoating the skin with Subbucus skin. We now sketch in the frame of the light reflections, by adding 1 part of Anthea skin to it. We furthermore make a 2:1 mix of Subbucus skin & nocturnal red & shade the naturally shaded areas (see reference photo). Add 1-2 parts of water.



We now add 1 part more of Anthea skin to the previous mix used for the frame of the light reflections, & glaze towards the center of the reflections. We furthermore shade in the recesses around the nose & eye brow, with a 1:1 mix of Subbucus skin & nocturnal red. Finally. I shaded inside the eye socket, with a 2:1 mix of nocturnal red & black.



We now add 1/3 part of white to the previous mix used for the light reflections, & glaze the center of the light reflections.



We now add a a 1/2 part more of white & glaze towards the very center of the light reflections.



We now add the last ½ part of white to the previous mix & glaze the very center of the light reflections. The mouth was then basecoated with a 1:1 mix of nocturnal red & black, & the teeth highlighted with Ivory. Done 😊
(Dont forget to paint her right arm, like i did :D)
