2) MAIN TOPIC: "GROWING THREAT" PRECON - BUDGET UPGRADE GUIDE

The rules: 10 cards in, 10 cards out. Total budget of around \$10. We'll leave the mana base as-is.

NEW COMMANDERS:

BRIMAZ, BLIGHT OF ORESKOS (main commander)

 Proliferating every turn is very powerful. You want to be sacrificing Phyrexians every turn if possible which is a great use of those little incubate tokens.

MOIRA AND TESHAR (secondary commander)

• Remember historic is legendary spells, sagas and artifacts.

WHO SHOULD YOU RUN AS THE COMMANDER?

Brimaz, Blight Of Oreskos

• The deck is so focused around the Phyrexian theme that it's hard not to use Brimaz as the Commander. There just aren't enough ways to enable the other commanders. Hard to get threats in graveyards in particular.

REPRINT VALUE

This only takes into account the value of the reprints (65) NOT the new cards.

Quick discussion about our evaluation of the deck right out-of-the-box and what the goal of the adds/subtractions were going into the "cards to add" section:

CARDS TO ADD

(remember: our total budget is around \$10 for this exercise)

SAC OUTLETS

• Chronomancer \$0.25

Another sac outlet for incubate tokens, plus it draws cards!

• Spawning Pit \$2.50

Another sac outlet that makes artifact creature tokens

• Costly Plunder \$0.25

Draws cards. Easy to leave up 2 mana because of incubate tokens

RAMP

• Scholar of New Horizons \$0.75

Ramp! Turns counters into card draw!

• Myr Convert \$0.25

Ramp!

• Inspiring Statuary \$0.50

Ramp!

• Everflowing Chalice \$1.25

Ramp! A great counter to proliferate

PHYREXIAN FODDER

Phyrexian Walker \$2.00

Cheap Phyrexian!

• Mite Overseer \$1.50

Makes Phyrexian fodder and buffs up your incubate tokens

• Annex Sentry \$0.25

Phyrexian + Targeted removal

Total = \$9.50

HONORABLE MENTIONS

Mondrak, Glory Dominus \$35.00

Phyrexian that cares about counters are all the right ingredients, but too expensive for a quick upgrade.

Resourceful Defense \$7.50

Moving counters from Incubator tokens to creatures is very powerful especially at instant speed, but not in the top 10

Door of Destinies \$18.00

A tribal artifact with a powerful counter to proliferate? This is everything the deck wants. Just a bit pricey

CARDS TO TAKE OUT

The curve in this deck is extremely high with 15 cards 6 mana value or more (23 that are 5 mana or more). Many of these cards were cut to lower the mana curve of the deck.

• Soul of New Phyrexia

Expensive board protection that is very difficult to hold up

• Shimmer Myr

Deck is not particularly concerned at moving at flash speed

Psychosis Crawler

Not going to be very impactful in this deck. Expensive for just a few points of damage

Ancient Stone Idol

Not a Phyrexian, just makes a big incubator token I guess?

Scytheclaw

Expensive and hard to take advantage of in this deck.

• First-Sphere Gargantua

Very expensive for only one card.

Orzhov Locket

Slow.

Shattered Angel

No additional lifegain synergy. Just Phyrexian

Coveted Jewel

Dangerous, expensive. Have to make sure you can sacrifice it at the right time.

Duplicant

Expensive.

HOW THE DECK PLAYS

Ramp your commander out ASAP (oftentimes better to hold cheap artifact creatures or Phyrexians until the commander is out) then start incubating. Use the incubator tokens to get value and eventually flip over the bigger ones and attack along with your big Phyrexians.
