



**Dirty beige  
cloth**

**Step-by-step**



# ◆ Paints required:

## Dirty beige cloth

- Rhinox hide
- Mournfang brown
- English uniform (vallejo mc)
- Zandri dust
- Ivory (Vallejo mc)
- Dawnstone







**Basecoat the cloth with a 1:1 mix of english uniform & zandri rust.**



**Layer all the raised areas with a 2:2:1 mix of zandri dust, english uniform & ivory.**





**We now glaze towards the sharpets edges on the cloth by adding 1 part more of ivory to the previous mix. Add 2-3 parts of water.**



**We now shade all the areas still covered in the basecoat with a 1:1 mix of uniform brown & mournfang brown – add 2-3 parts of water.**





We now shade the lower half of cloth with mournfang brown – add 3-4 parts of water. We furthermore make some random patterns on the lower quarter of the cloth with rhinox hide – add 2-3 parts of water.



We now edge highlight the upper  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the cloth, with a 2:1 mix of ivory & zandri dust. We also edge highlight the lower quarter of the cloth with dawnstone & furthermore highlight all the sharpest tips with pure ivory.





**Optional: Leave a couple of random small dots here & there with a 1:1 mix of mournfang brown & rhinox hide. Furthermore make some scratches here & there by painting thin lines & dots, with a 2:1 mix of ivory & zandri dust. Done!**
