EXCAVATION

- This is the site of a new residential chamber of Brazenthrone being carved out of the mountain. This chamber is currently unnamed.
- The excavation is being done from the top down. Miners started at the highest part of the chamber, digging out a layer of rock at the top, then digging out a layer below that, then below that, all the way to the ground. Over half of the chamber has been dug out this way, although a fair amount of work remains to be done.
- While the majority of the labor being done is by miners carving out the rock, almost as many dwarves are employed here to haul off the stone for disposal. This is brought by wagon to the waste rock disposal site in the Oreworks, where it is disposed of with the mine's tailings.
- With the exception of natural caverns like the Noble Quarter and the Opaline Grotto, most of Brazenthrone was once dug out in the same manner as this.
- This isn't the most elaborate area of the city, but it could make an interesting location for a fight.
