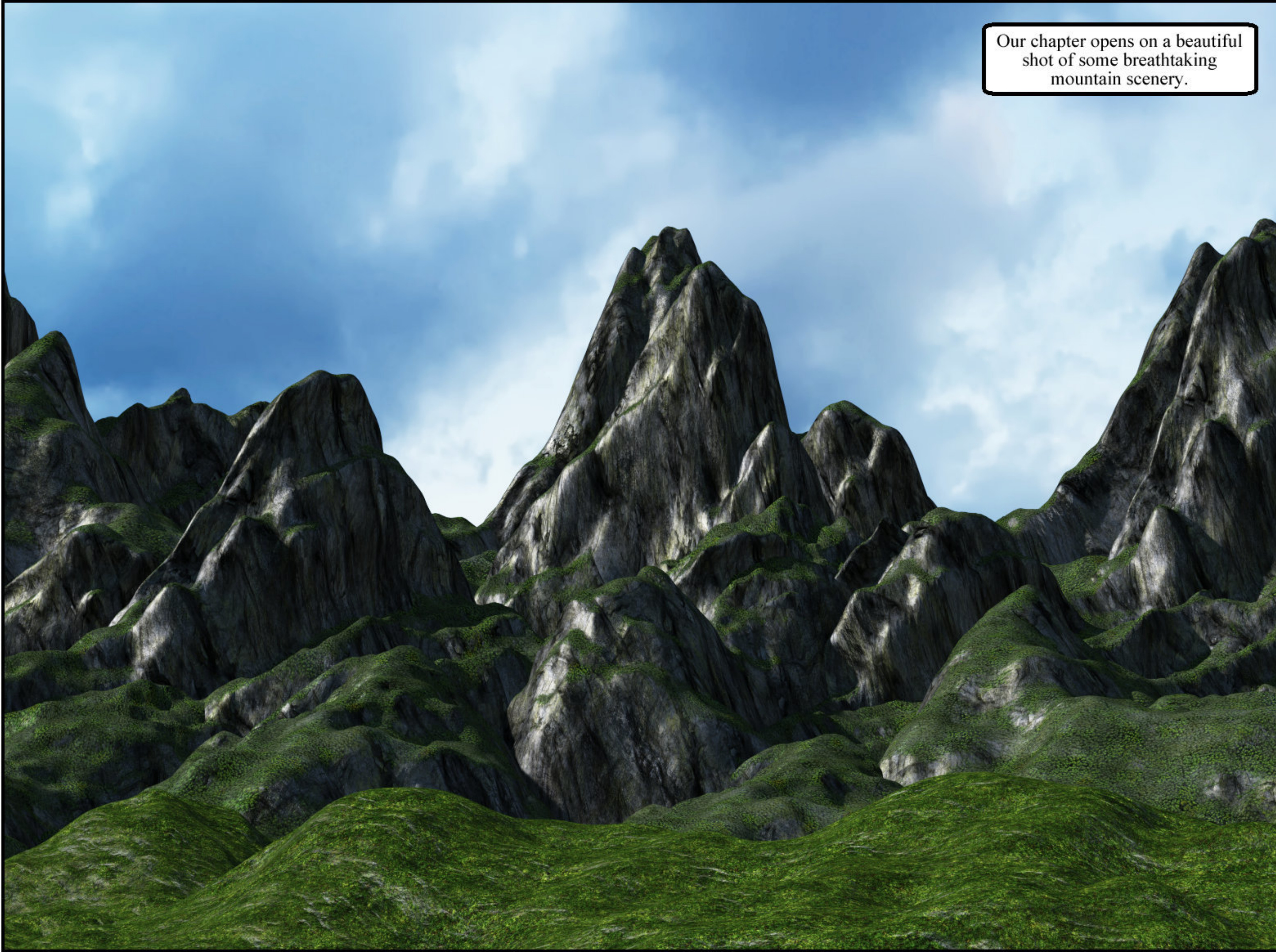

hurt you.**

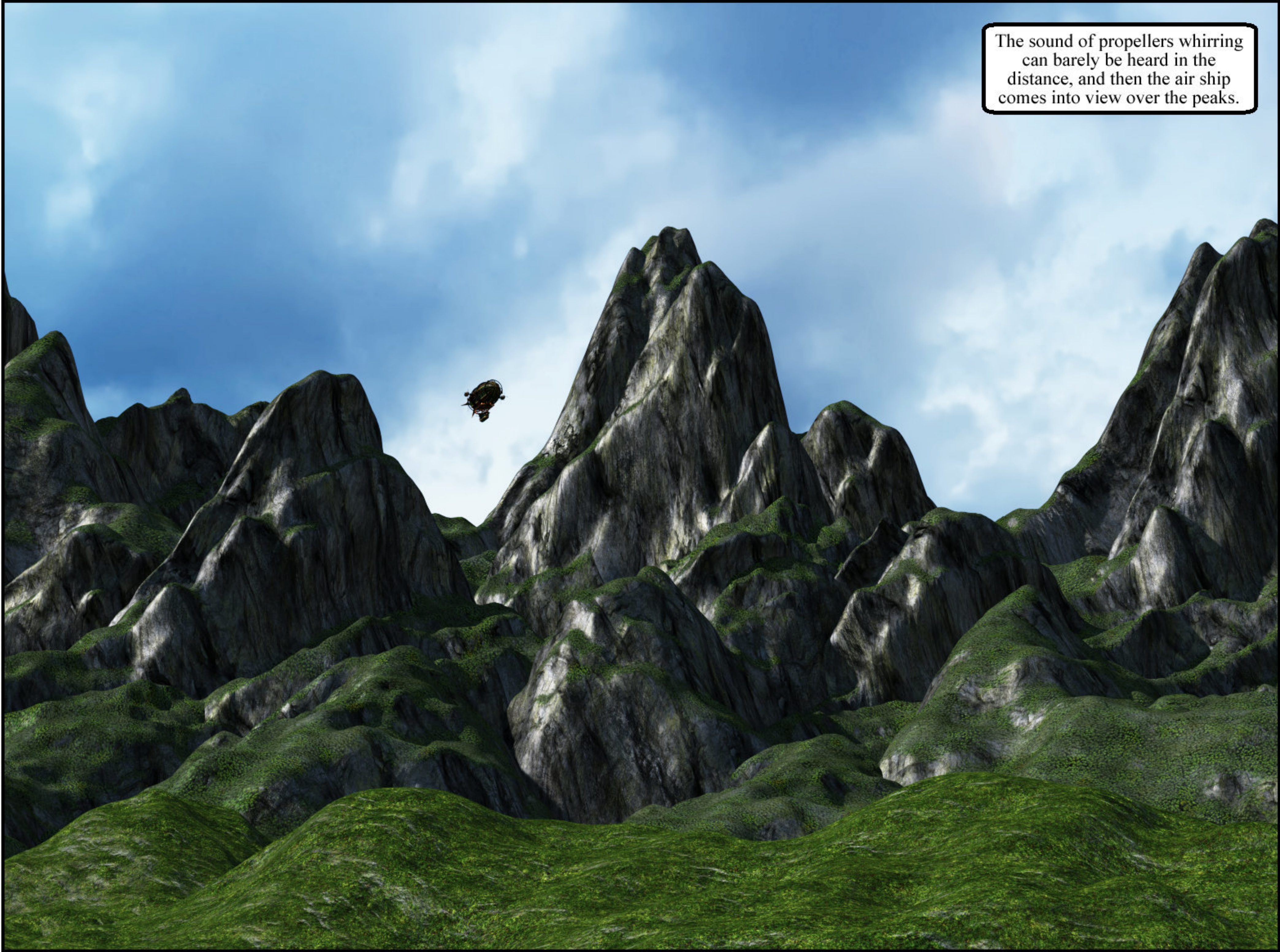

As she looks out the window, she realizes that she has been to this place before.


When Sapphire announces that she knows the place, all of the girls start firing questions at her at the same time.

We're all doomed then.

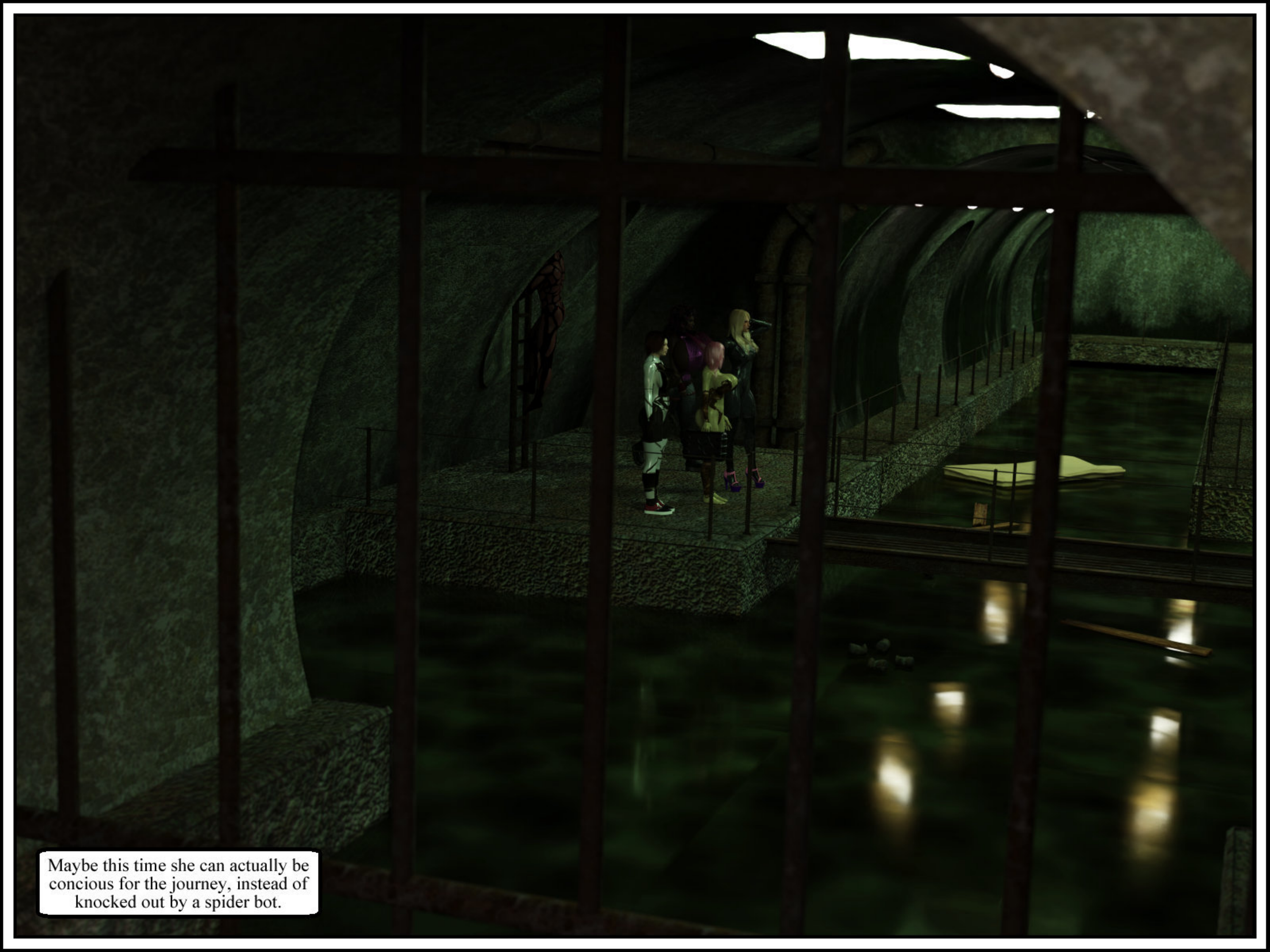
Worse than doomed. <Snort>

The crew take their time searching the city for a way down, as Sapphire knows that the lair of the Spider Queen was definitely underground.



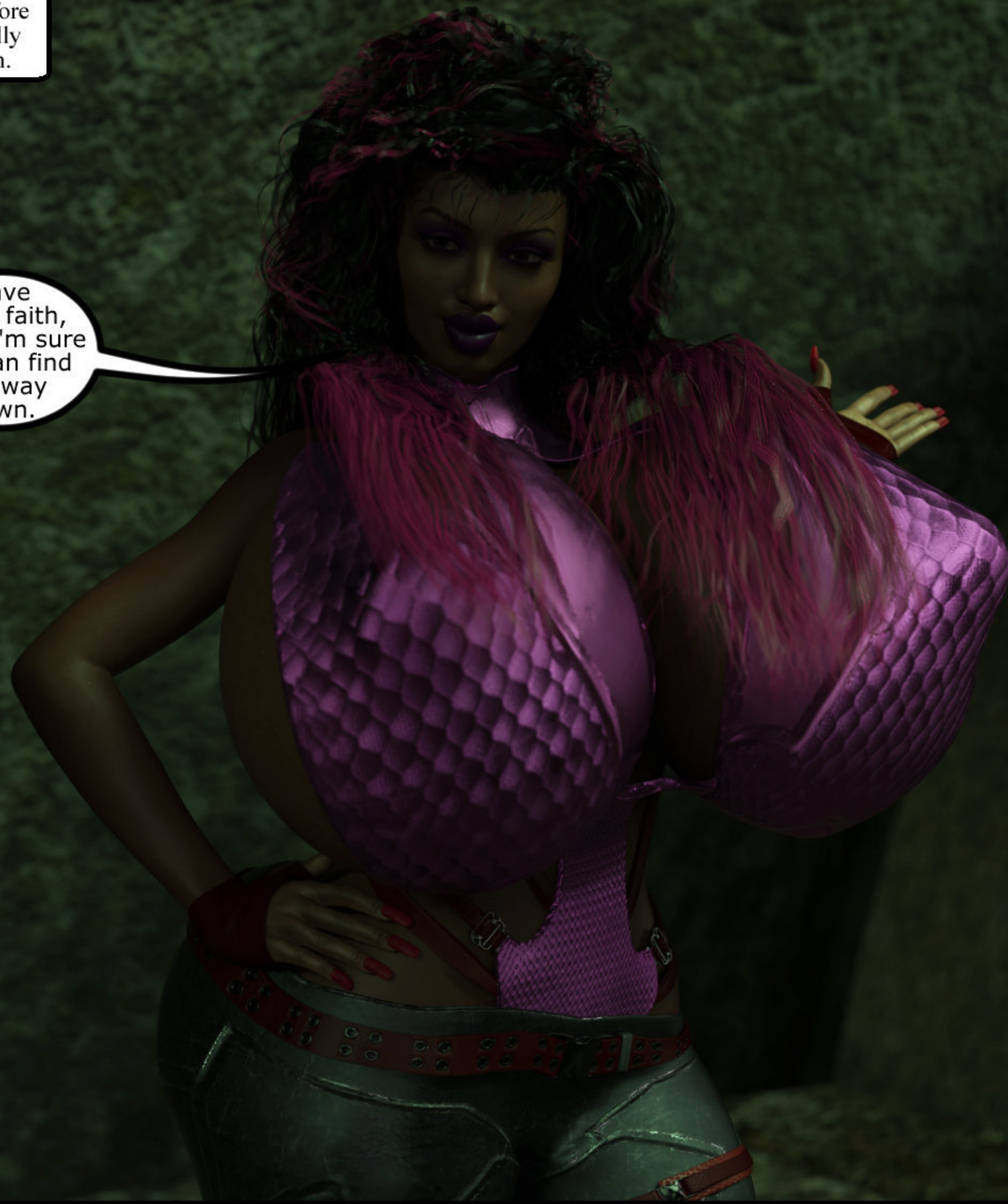
But they only find a single path that leads below the rubble of the ruined city, which happens to be the sewers.

If this was not here the last time you visited, then who or what put it here.

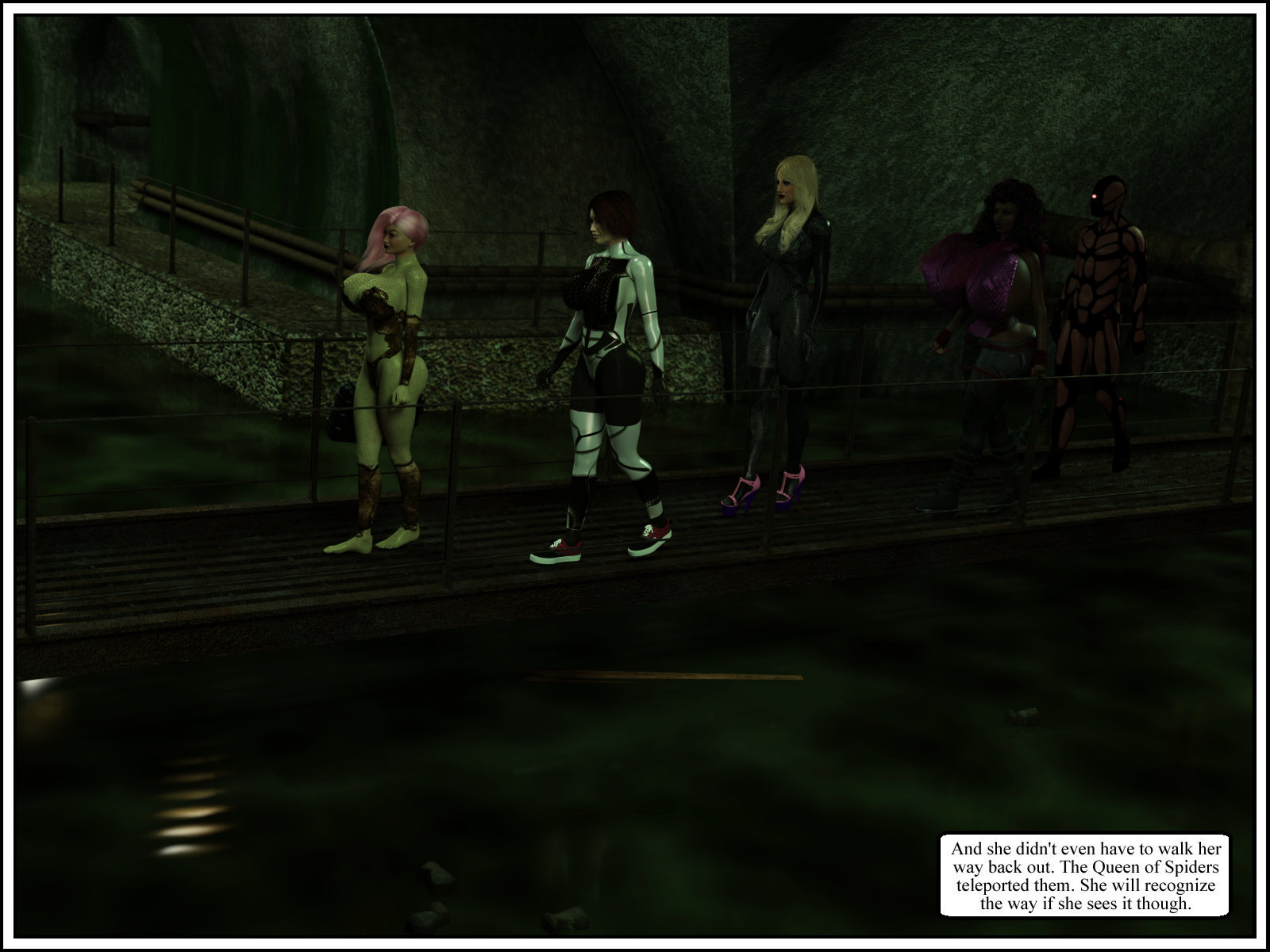
No worries, Saffy. It's confusing down here. Just try again.

Haha! Oops. I swear this wasn't here last time.

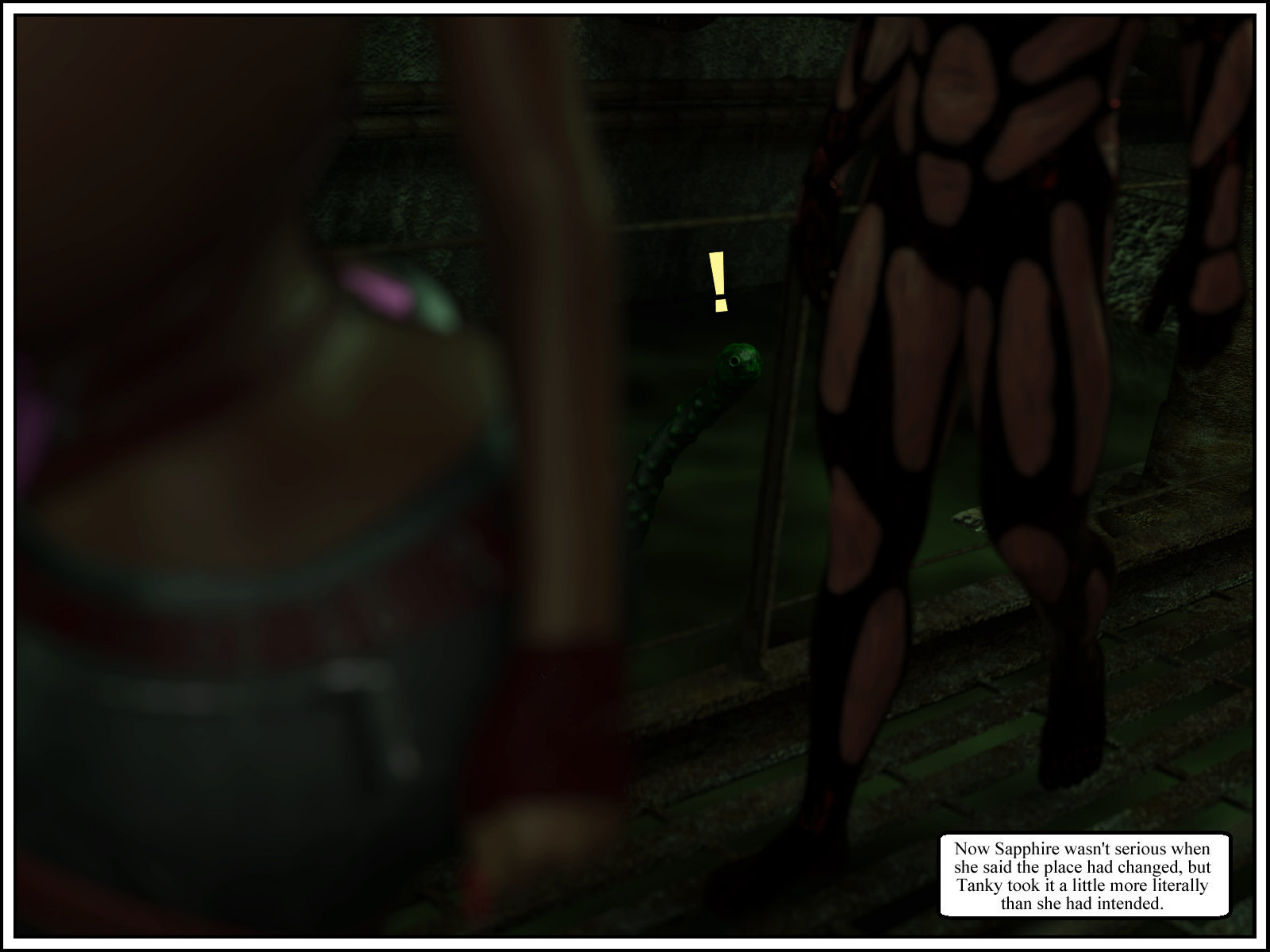
Told you.

The two of them might have had a point without even knowing it, as there seems to be something watching them from the slime.




What's more, the eyeball's gaze seems to be locked onto some of the more pronounced parts of our lady's fine figures.



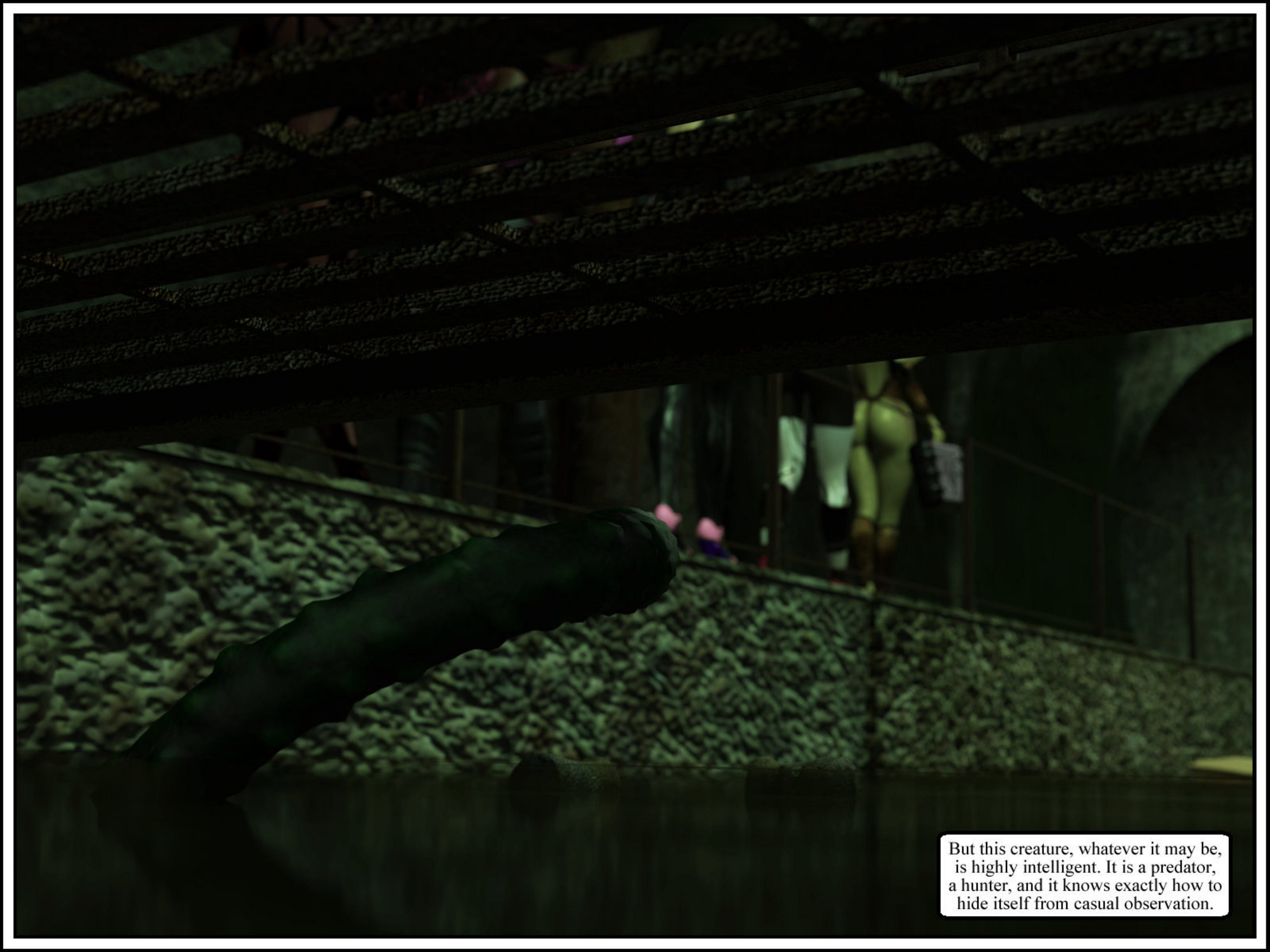
What was that?!

find...


Hiiissss!
