## Process

For this art, ( with the brush "Stump Pencil ) I wanted to convey something natural and deep but with a touch of magic. And as you can see, I jumped directly into a scribble of a person looking at a landscape. Leaving as a message to myself, how much I wanted to draw something with water in this drawing.

→ Notice how dark the reflection gets when is close to the person.

But if you're an undecided artist like me, you're definitely going to change the first thing you draw. In that case, I now turned that woman into a girl wearing a swimsuit lying on a rock in the middle of a lake.

The color of the water even for this situation, does not necessarily need to be black. That depends a lot on the kind of water you want for your drawing.

It was hard for me to decide between a milky water and a dark-reflective water.

But I chose black because I felt more familiar.

It's up to the artist.

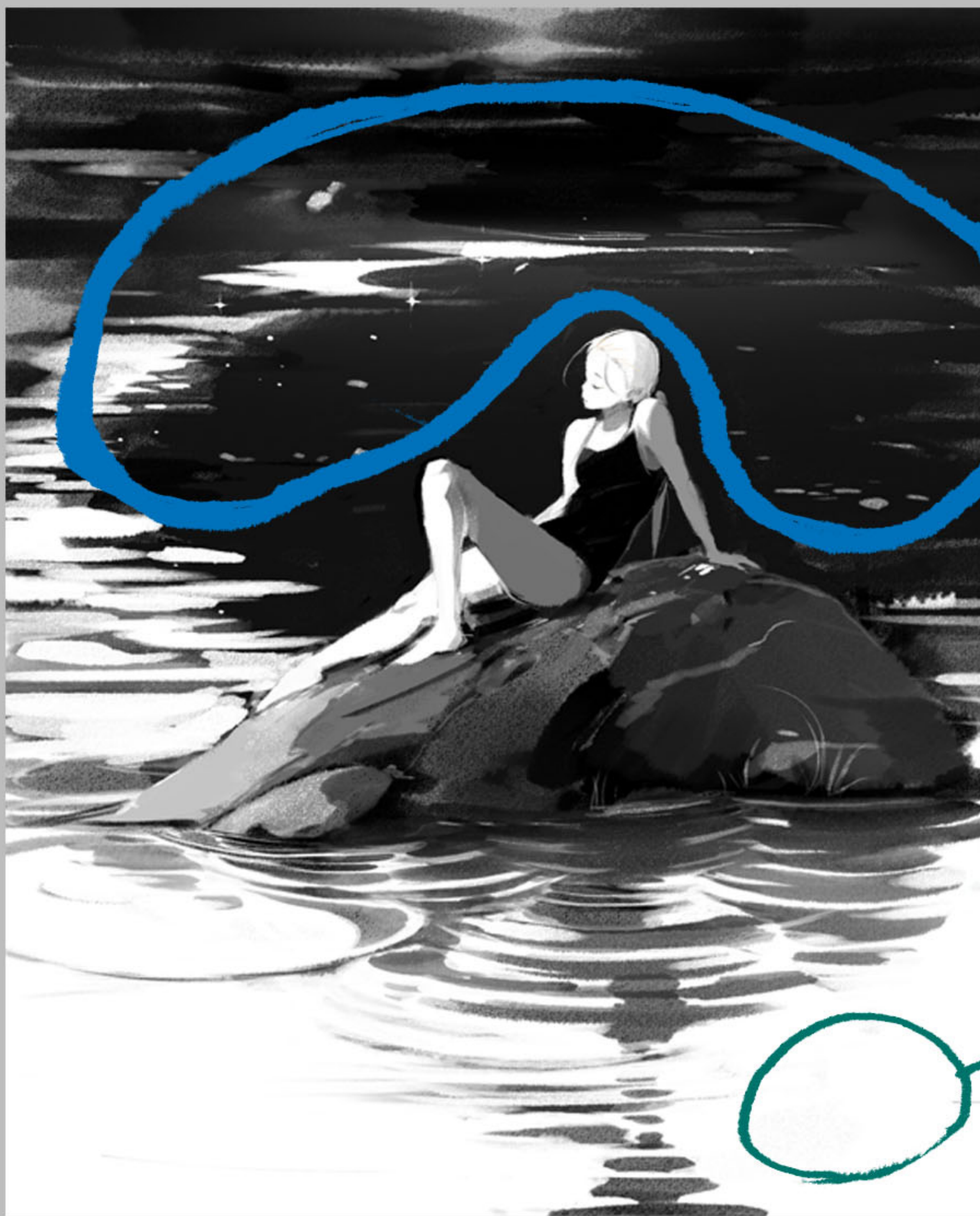

The white color would be the reflection of the sky.



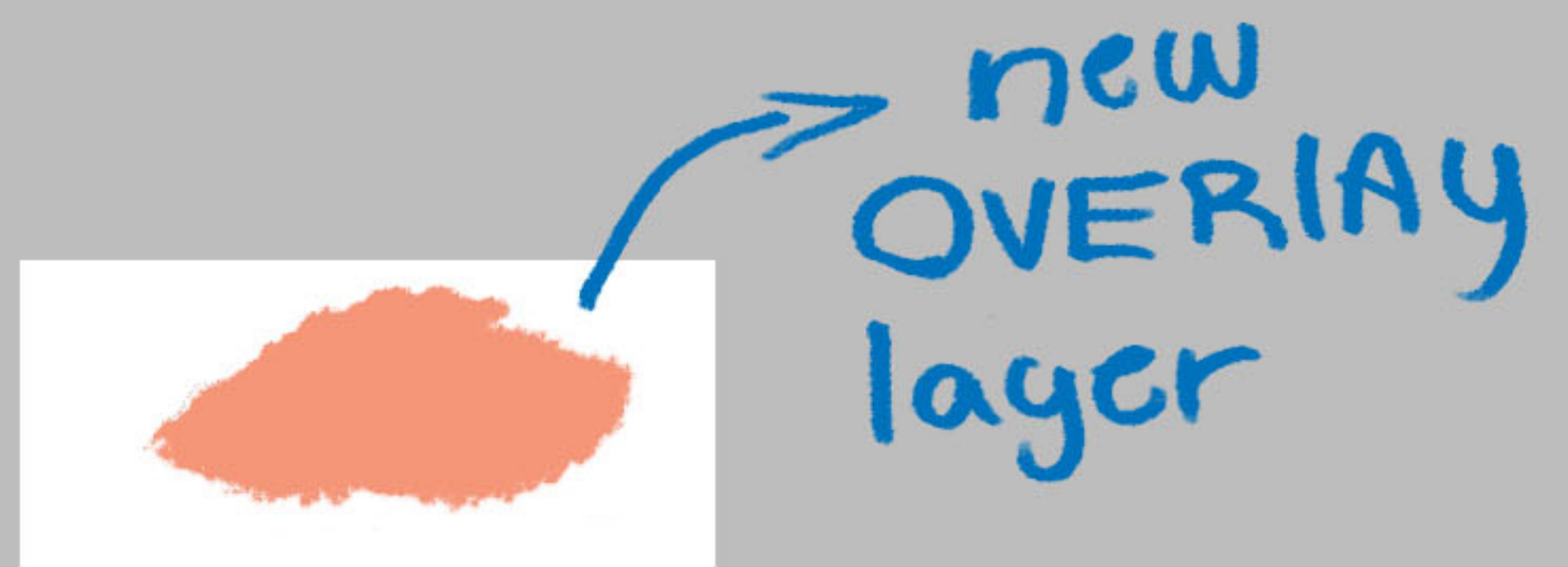

# Adding details :

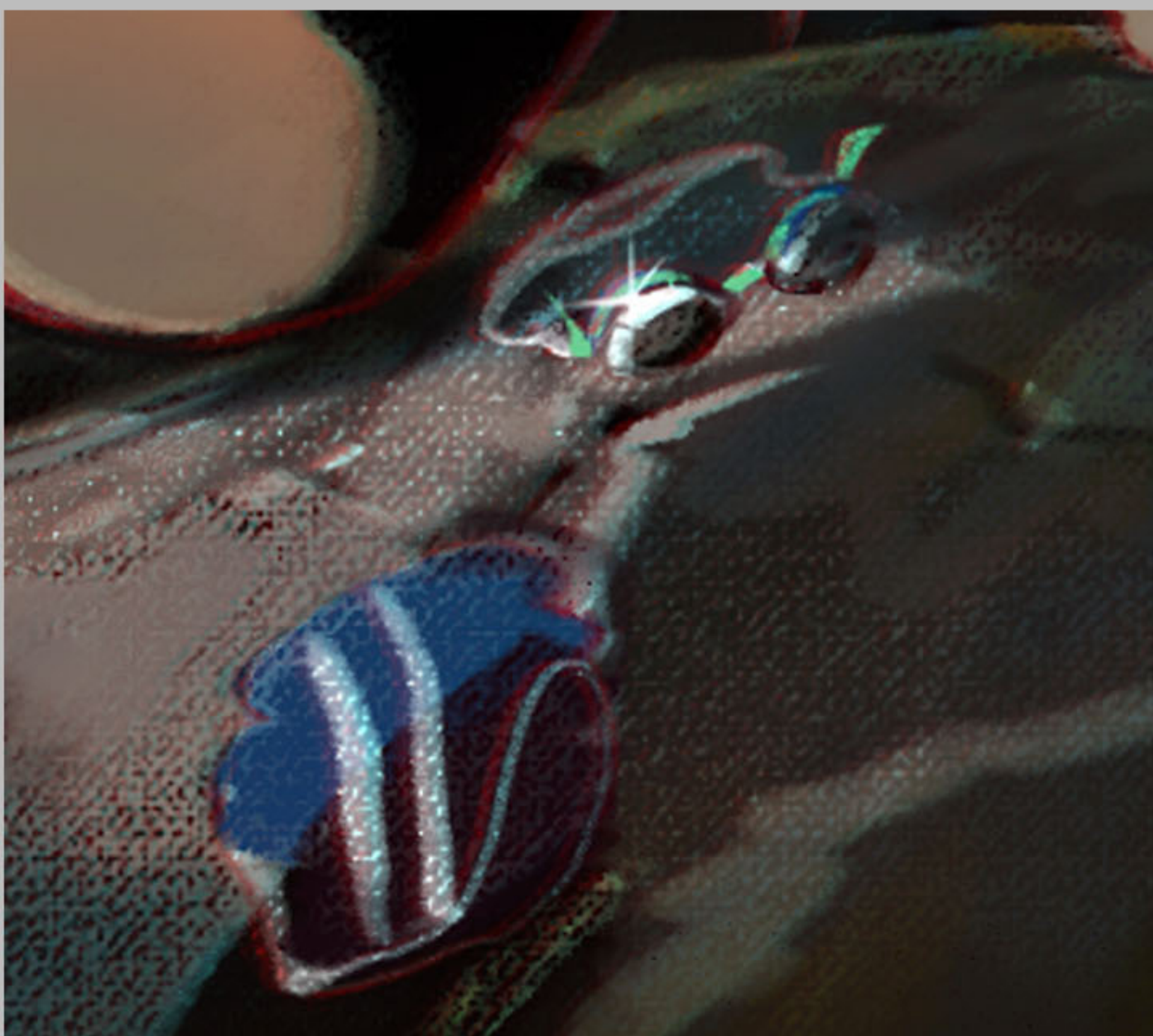


→ Try turning off "G" and "B" from "Blending" Options, and move it a little, just to give that 3D effect.

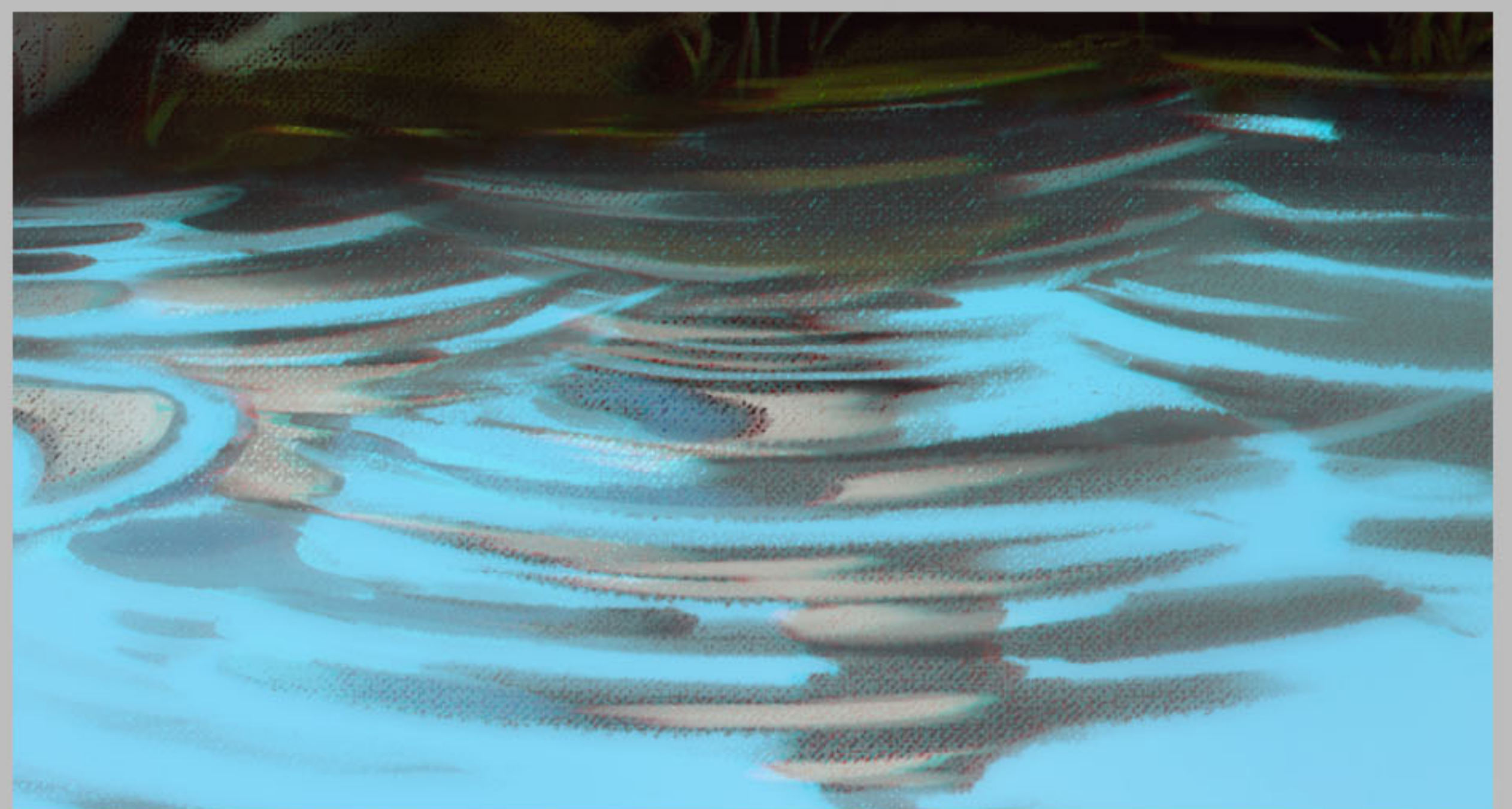


I increased the saturation level to make colors more vibrant.
